Boston Public Schools Is Back In Remote Learning Again

The Boston Public Health Commission (BPHC) released data showing the citywide seven-day COVID-19 positivity rate increased to 5.7%. This is an increase from 4.5% last week and from 4.1% two weeks before.

Therefore, out of an abundance of caution, Mayor Walsh and Superintendent Caselli have decided to suspend in-person learning for all students. **Effective Thursday, October 22, all BPS students will learn remotely until public health data shows a downward trend in positive COVID-19 cases.**

Some of our families received communication within the last week notifying them of their child's in-person start date. That information has now unfortunately changed due to this news. There will be no in-person learning until further notice.

We remain committed to providing all of our students with high-quality and equitable teaching and learning until our return.

I, as well as all of our teaching staff are feeling very confident in believing that we did this well in the spring and can do it even better now!

We thank you collectively for all you that you are continuing to do at home with your students as well. We know that this is difficult and that you are all doing your best.

We ask that you allow grace and patience with your child/children's teacher's as they communicate with you around their expectations for learning attendance and student engagement.
